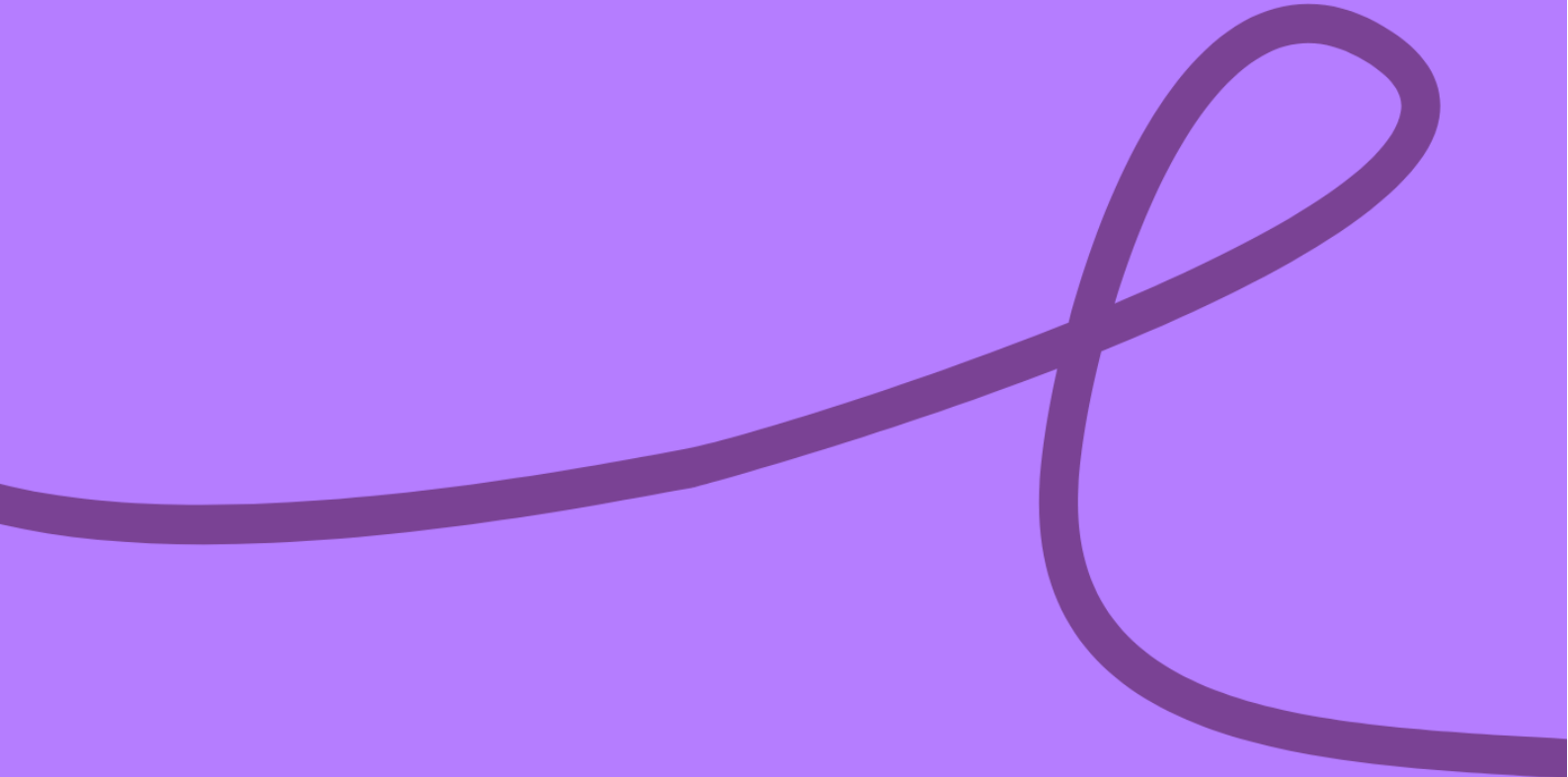

To deliver Open Awards qualifications, units or programmes, you will need to complete a provider approval process. All Open Awards providers are fully supported through the approval process by our experienced team. If you are ready to apply to be approved by Open Awards, please complete the [New Business Enquiry Form](#) or contact the team on 0151 494 2072 or enquiries@openawards.org.uk.

The Provider Approval Fee is a non-refundable, one-off fee to cover the cost of the review of your application. The fee includes dedicated support with producing and reviewing the required policies and procedures; curriculum planning support; and agreeing an action plan collaboratively.

Annual Provider Recognition Fee

All approved providers pay an annual provider recognition fee. This is based on the number of learner registrations from the previous academic year (1st August – 31st July). This fee gives you access to online quality and compliance training activities; ongoing curriculum planning support; and advice and guidance from a dedicated Quality and Standards Advisor.

The annual recognition fee will be pro-rata'd in the first year.

Experienced Worker Assessment (EWA)

The Experienced Worker Assessment (EWA) is the assessment process to recognise occupational competence for people who have been working in a relevant industry role, normally for over five (5) years, but haven't been able to complete an equivalent Level 3 vocational qualification.

The Experienced Worker Assessment is based on the qualification requirements as defined in accordance with the associated ECS Card, so that both new entrants and existing workers are now being assessed and accredited against the same industry standard.

The assessment has been approved by the Joint Industry Board and ECS.
